


# Outdoor Adventure Camp

Carrabassett Valley Recreation Department

Greetings OAC Community,

I hope this email finds you and your family well. This letter is to update you on the final decision made by the leadership in Carrabassett on how Outdoor Adventure Camp will operate this year.

Following the guidelines from the CDC and taking every preventative measure to provide a safe outdoor experience for kids; instead of Outdoor Adventure Camp, we will be running: **Outdoor Adventure Programs for Summer 2020.**

This modified camp experience will be open to children ages 6-13 who are enrolled in the local school systems: Carrabassett Valley School Department, MSAD 58 and Eustis School Department. There will be one program offering a day, Monday - Friday. Kids enrolled in the Carrabassett Valley school department will have first priority, then reservations will be taken on a first come first serve basis. **Reservations are required as space is limited.**

Outdoor Adventure Programs will run the same 6 weeks that OAC was scheduled to, with similar times 9am OR 10 am-3pm. What will look very different this year is; we will not be transporting campers; parents will be asked to drop off and pick up at alternative locations on days of hikes and biking. We will not have weekly overnights, kids and staff will be asked to keep a 6' physical distance from others and we will all have to wear a face covering when this is not possible. We will also need to cancel camp on bad weather days. No decisions have been easy, but we feel that this is the safest way to offer recreational and social opportunities to local children this summer.

Part of keeping this local is also asking staff and campers to do their best to prevent the spread of the virus. We will have strict cleaning protocols, hand washing procedures, along with daily health checks and temperature readings. We ask everyone involved with camp to abide by the 2 week quarantine if you leave the state or interact with an infected person, prior to attending camp. If the situation with the virus worsens, camp could be canceled at any point.

This decisions was made based on what we know about COVID-19 with the health and safety of the community in mind. Thank you all for the patience and understanding you have shown during this time of uncertainty.
