## ADVENTURE CAMP

**Carrabassett Valley Recreation Department**

**Ages 4-13 years**

**July 6 - August 14, 2020: Monday-Friday, 9:00 AM-3:30 PM**

Camp activities may include: swimming, fly fishing, tennis, golf, wall climbing, water sports, cooperative and competitive field and ball games; arts and crafts; hiking and mountain biking; dramatics; those inevitable rain day plans; weekly themes covering environmental awareness; ecology, local heritage, nature, and weather. We hope to familiarize the children with all that makes our corner of the world so special, share lots of fun and laughter, and to build their self-confidence. We want to empower them to better "Live in the outside" and be avid environmental stewards. This camp is made available through the Town of Carrabassett Valley's Recreation Department and the generosity of Carrabassett Valley Taxpayers.

### **Fees & Overnight Trips**

Area guests: \$235 per week, \$135 for 3-days, \$50 per day.

Carrabassett Valley taxpayers: \$145 per week, \$110 for 3-days, or \$40 per day.

Year-round area residents (enrolled in local school systems): \$100 per week, \$80 for 3-days, or \$30 per day.

(Local resident and taxpayer camperships are generously subsidized by Carrabassett Valley Taxpayers)

Weekly overnight trips will be available for ages 8 and up as part of full week enrollment. The cost is \$45-\$60 per camper, which includes supervision, fees, and three meals. Space is limited.

### **Peak Baggers & Gadabouts**

Carrabassett Valley is surrounded by many majestic mountains. Campers 8 years old and up have the option to take on the challenge to climb a different peak each week with Peak Baggers. Gadabouts is our weekly hiking program for the younger age groups. In recognition of their efforts, hikers are given a descriptive keepsake identifying the destination and a special caddy to keep them in. Naturally, all the campers who participate experience a tremendous amount of pride in their achievements!

### **Camper Daily Needs**

Hat, bathing suit, towel, reusable water bottle, appropriate clothing for the weather and planned activities, sneakers or sturdy closed toe shoes, and plenty of fluids (no glass containers). We are striving for 100% participation with "No Trash" lunches and snacks (reusable containers) every day, and will be tracking our success! Labeling your child's belongings is appreciated. Please supply sunscreen (bug repellent, too if you choose) and apply the first coat before each camp day starts. Communicate any special instructions to your child's counselors and the office.

### **Reservations**

Reservations are required. Payment is due on the first day of camp attendance each week. For refund or credit, cancellations must be made prior to the day being canceled.

### **Child Care**

Children ages 10 weeks to four years are welcome to join the State of Maine Licensed program at Western Maine Center for Children on a space available basis. The center is located at the Carrabassett Valley Public Library & Community Center.
