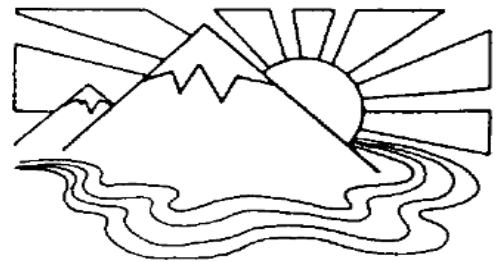


OUTDOOR

Ages 5 -13 years

Drop off begins on Monday morning at 8:45am.

Please join us at 3:15pm each day for our closing circle.

Camp activities may include swimming, tennis, golf, wall climbing, water sports, cooperative and competitive field and ball games; arts and crafts; hiking and mountain biking; dramatics; weekly themes covering environmental awareness; ecology, local heritage, nature, and weather. We hope to familiarize the children with all that makes our corner of the world so special, share lots of fun and laughter, and to build their self-confidence. We want to empower them to better “Live in the outside” and be avid environmental stewards.

2024 Fees: Payment is due in full by June 1st.

~ **Area guests:** \$290 per week, OR \$58 per day.

~ **Carrabassett Valley Taxpayers:** \$180 per week OR \$36 per day.

** The taxpayer rate applies to dependents of taxpayers

~ **Year-round area residents** (campers enrolled in local school systems): \$130 per week, OR \$26 per day.

(Local resident and taxpayer campers are generously subsidized by Carrabassett Valley taxpayers)

Teams & Age Groups

YELLOW: ages 5 & 6 - campers going into K & 1st grade

GREEN: ages 7 & 8 - campers going into 2nd & 3rd grade

RED: ages 9 & 10 - campers going into 4th & 5th grade

BLUE: ages 11-13 - campers going into 6th - 8th grade

CIT: Ages 14 & 15 - counselor in training

Reservations

Reservations are required as space is limited. Reservations open up at 8:00am on: March 2nd for CV residents, March 16th for CV Taxpayers and Local School children and March 30th for everyone else. Please note: campers can register for up to 5 of the 6 weeks of camp.

Camper Daily Needs

Please label all of your child's belongings

All campers should have with them daily:

- A backpack to carry belongings
- Hat to protect from the sun
- Bathing suit and towel
- Closed toed shoes
- Refillable water bottles
- Healthy lunch and snacks - please no glass containers
*** we strive for trash free lunches - help us keep the Valley clean and beautiful!
- Weather & activity appropriate clothing - we are outside all day
- Sunblock with the first application applied prior to getting to camp

Please leave at home:

- Soda or sugary snacks
- Toys, electronics & cell phones

** To keep campers present with their group, we do not allow campers to bring cell phones to camp. If this is a need for after camp, please see Anne and leave the device in the office till after hours.*

Biking Groups:

Rumble Riders: designed for younger riders who are not yet ready for single track.



Rough Riders: OAC's Mountain bike program. For campers who are ready for single track. Beginners - Advanced riders

Hiking Groups:

Gadabouts: local hikes and nature walks. Designed for our younger campers.



Peak Baggers: These are full day hikes designed for older campers with the goal of bagging a local peak.
