AGC Frequently Asked Questions

Do we need release forms?

A current release form needs to be signed by the parent or guardian of a minor.

Release forms are available at the AGC or may be downloaded @ www.carrabassettvalley.org.

How old does a child have to be to participate unattended?

Any child 13 years old and older is invited to come use the facility without an adult if they have a current waiver on file.

What method of payment is accepted at the AGC?

We accept cash, checks or credit cards. Checks need to be made out to either the Antigravity Complex or the Town of Carrabassett Valley. An ATM is located at Mountain Side Grocers which is within walking distance to the AGC.

How far in advance do I need to make reservations for skateboard lessons, the trampoline or Clem's Climbing A minimum of a 48 hours' notice is required.

Why do you have variable hours of operation?

We have a partnership with Carrabassett Valley Academy (CVA). They utilize the facility throughout the day for training. Those hours change upon the season.

Is it mandatory to wear a helmet and pads in the skate park?

Helmets are <u>ALWAYS</u> required in the skate park and bowl. Other safety equipment is strongly suggested and required during private lessons.

Can I purchase a day pass to the facility? Day passes are available for \$7.00 for youths and \$10.00 for adults. The day pass includes the basketball courts, fitness/spin room, skate park and the workout area. Waivers must be completed.

What activities are allowed in the skate park?

Skateboarding and roller blading.

What should I bring with me to the facility?

Clean indoor shoes! Outdoor shoes are not permitted. A water bottle is highly recommended as we have a water bottle filler however <u>no</u> water fountain is available.

Multi-Passes?

We offer Youth and Adult Multi-passes along with gift certificates. They make a wonderful gift.
