Dear Members of the Golf Course Greens Committee:

We will be meeting at 3:00 p.m. this Wednesday (Dec. 21<sup>st</sup>) at the Library. Please find attached some brief minutes of the Dec. 1<sup>st</sup> meeting. Also, please find attached the golf course priority list that Ryan provided at the last meeting.

John B, Karl, Ryan, John D and myself met on Friday to review this list and we came up with the following recommendations for Committee Review:

Complete Drainage Project on the 6<sup>th</sup> Green in the spring (contract out): \$40K to \$50.

Complete Drainage Projects on Green Areas #2,13 and 14 in house for approximately \$50 in the fall.

Purchase Radio Signal Booster (upgrade to irrigation system) for approximately \$10K.

Both Town and Sugarloaf to contribute \$45K (each) to the Golf Course Reserve in 2023 (as opposed to \$10K each) and expend approximately \$50K in 2023 to pave some cart paths.

Restocking Bunker Sand is Sugarloaf's responsibility.

Look at the possibility of rebuilding and drainage work on #7 fairway in conjunction with building the Par 3 golf course.

This will be the subject for discussion on Wednesday. Hope to see you!
